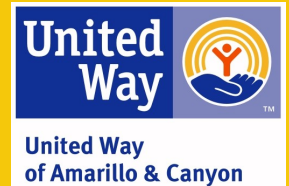

One day, in a particularly fierce outburst of anger, the aunt burned Hannah's tiny arm with a lighter.



Even 3-year-old Hannah knew something was wrong – so she told a teacher at her daycare what was happening to her. Hannah was brought to The Bridge and now is in foster care with a family that truly loves her. She receives counseling services so she can work through the horrible trauma she has endured at such a young age. Her aunt was charged with injury to a child and is now awaiting sentencing.
